Ownership and Copyright

The Product described in this document, including all supporting materials, is a proprietary product of General Vision, referred to as GV.

GV retains all title and copyrights in and to the Product, its accompanying printed materials or electronic documentation. All rights reserved. No parts of any material or documentation may be reproduced in any form or by any means - graphic, electronic, or mechanical, including photocopying, recording, taping, or information storage and retrieval systems - without the written permission of GV.

Limited Warranty

General for hardware products

GV warrants that Products sold under this document will, at the time of shipment, be free from defects in material and workmanship and will conform to GV's approved specifications.

If Products are not as warranted, GV will, at its option, and as Buyer's sole and exclusive remedy, either refund the purchase price, repair, or replace with the same or equivalent Products that meet this warranty. Buyer must obtain a Return Material Authorization ("RMA") number and return nonconforming Products to GV's designated facility. Unless otherwise specified, our default warranty period for hardware products is 6-months. Your rights of repair or replacement of any Products which are found to be defective will be negated or rendered void where Products have been repaired or altered by persons other than us or any authorized dealer; defective Product or Products have not been returned together with full details in writing of the alleged defects within the warranty period from the date on which such Products were delivered; and/or

defects are due (wholly or partially) to mistreatment, improper use or storage or maintenance or installation, or failure to observe our instructions or other directions issued or made available by us in connection with the delivered Products.

Hardware products are warranted for a period of six (6) months from date of shipment.

Development products provided "AS IS", including without limitation prototypes and pre-production samples (whether paid for or not), are provided "AS IS" and are not covered by any of the above warranties unless otherwise agreed in writing.

General for software products

GV warrants that the Product will perform substantially in accordance with the accompanying written materials or electronic documentation and GV will make reasonable efforts to solve any problem issues arising out of the intended use of the Product. Software products are maintained free of charge for a period of one year from the date of purchase.

Limitation of Liability

The Licensed Software is a proprietary product of General Vision. General Vision retains all title and copyrights in and to the Licensed Software, its accompanying printed materials, electronic documentation and any complete or partial copies.

Software Application License

General Vision grants to the End-User a revocable, non-transferable, and non-exclusive license to use the Software product. This license may not be shared or used concurrently on different computers. You may install one copy of the Software product, or any prior version, on a single computer for use by a single user. End-User may make one copy of Software product for backup purposes. No other

copies shall be made without General Vision’s prior written consent.

Software Development Kit License

You can use the Software Development Kit (SDK) licenses for creating applications for internal or commercial use. SDK licenses follow a named-user licensing policy, tied to an individual user who can install the software on up to three computers at any given time. The software may be executing on only one computer at a time.

If an application developed with the SDK requires an interface to a hardware platform featuring a NeuroMem network, whether composed of one or multiple NeuroMem chips, it can be distributed without any Application Deployment License. If an application developed with the SDK only uses a simulation of a NeuroMem network and does not require interface to a NeuroMem hardware, it requires an Application Deployment License from General Vision.

Application Deployment License

A deployment license is required for distributing an application which is developed with a Software Development Kit and does not require an interface to a hardware NeuroMem network.
